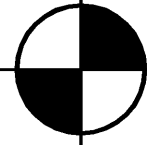

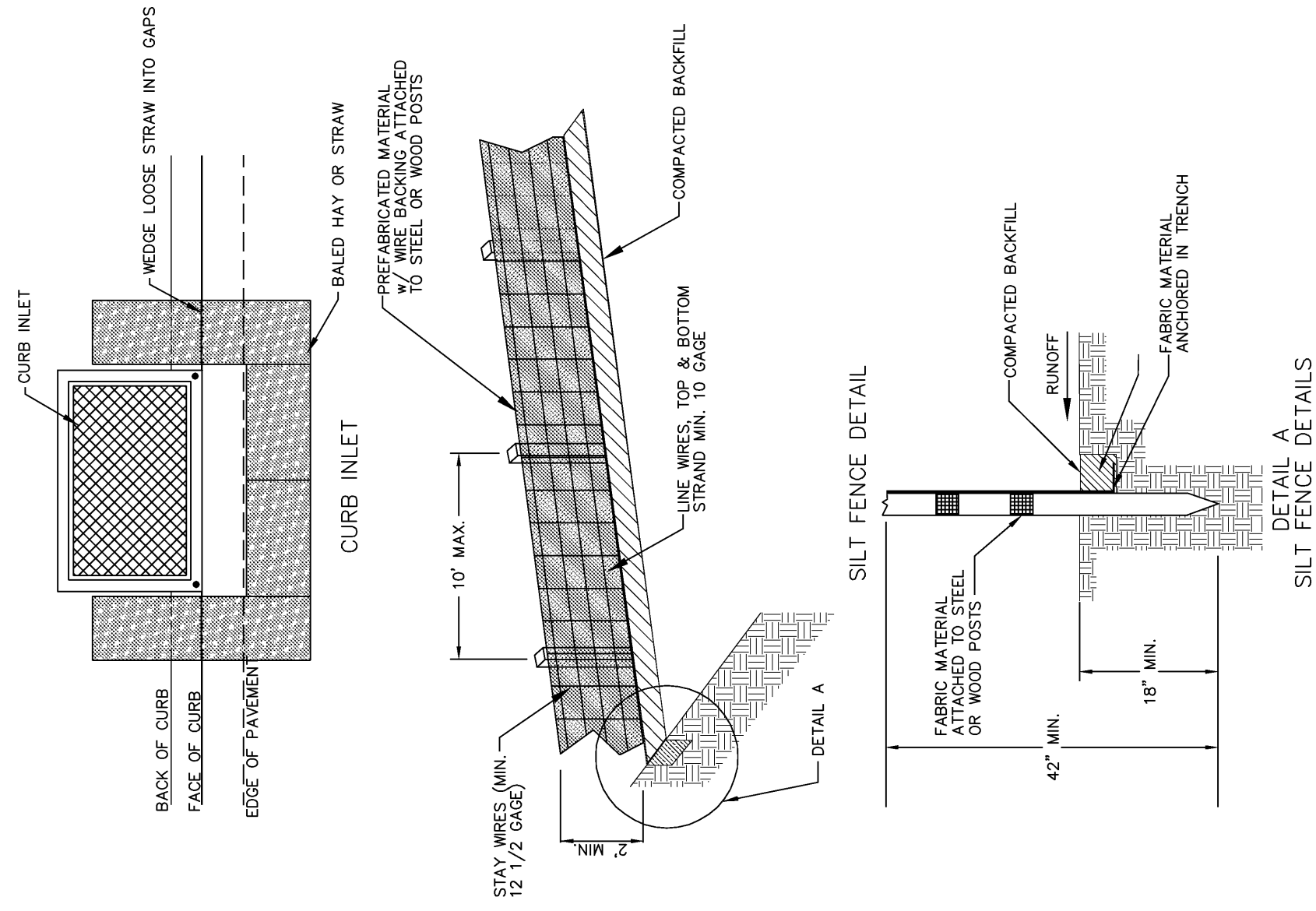

AND REMOVAL OF THE AIRPORT CONTROL, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE INSTALLED AT LOCATIONS NECESSARY TO MAINTAIN THE FLOW OF TRAFFIC THROUGH THE AIRPORT.

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1. WIRE SHALL BE A MINIMUM OF 32" IN WIDTH AND SHALL HAVE A MINIMUM OF 6 LINE WIRES WITH 12" STAY SPACING.
2. GEOTEXTILE FABRIC SHALL BE A MINIMUM OF 36" IN WIDTH AND SHALL BE FASTENED ADEQUATELY TO THE WIRE.
3. STEEL POSTS SHALL BE 5" IN HEIGHT AND OF THE SELF STANCHION ANGLE STEEL TYPE. WOOD POSTS SHALL BE A MINIMUM OF 5" IN HEIGHT AND 4" OR MORE IN DIAMETER.
4. WIRE SHALL BE FASTENED TO WOODEN POSTS WITH NOT LESS THAN 9 GAGE STAPLES 1" LONG.
